

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the King George Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King George Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the RPV Plan of Organization (State Party Plan) and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Ron McElrath, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the L.E. Smoot Memorial Library, Meeting Room B, 9533 Kings Hwy, King George, VA 22485, starting at 7:00pm local time on Thursday, March 19, 2020 for the following purposes:

- A. Electing a Chairman of the King George Republican Committee
- B. Electing Delegates/Alternates for the 1st Congressional District Convention to be held June 13th, 2020.
- C. Electing Delegates/Alternates for the RPV State Convention to be held May 1st-2nd, 2020.
- D. Electing members of the King George Republican Committee.

Qualifications for Participation

In accordance with Article 1 of the State Party Plan, all legal and qualified voters of King George County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the November 3, 2020 election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Certification of Delegates

Delegates and alternate delegates to the Convention shall be certified to the Convention, in the case of those selected by a Mass Meeting or Convention, by the permanent chairman and permanent secretary of the Mass Meeting or Convention; or in the case of those selected by a Party Canvass, or those declared elected pursuant to the call of a cancelled Mass Meeting, Party Canvass, or Convention, they shall be certified by the chairman of the unit committee.

Certifications must include at least the name and address appearing on the voter registration rolls of each delegate and alternate, as well as an indication of which delegates or alternates, if any, are Military Members certified as delegates pursuant to Art. VIII, Sec. H, para: 6 of the State Party Plan, so that the eligibility of such delegates or alternates to have their votes cast by candidate preference ballot may be determined.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the elections or nomination at said mass meeting shall submit the completed and relevant filing form and fee(s) by mail, to King George Republican Committee, P.O. Box 221 King

George, VA 22485, or in person to any officer of the King George Republican Committee, which must be received not later than 5:00 PM on Monday, March 09, 2020 postmarks will not govern.

The candidates for election of Committee Chairman will remit with their filing form and fee; a check for \$100.00 made payable to the King George Republican Committee. The filing form can be picked up from Ron McElrath, 540-429-0481 and online at www.RPV.org. If there is only one properly filed candidate for Chairman of the King George Republican Committee that candidate will be deemed elected.

Candidates seeking election for Delegate to the 1st Congressional District must submit the relevant filing form by March 09, 2020 and shall include with their filing form a check or evidence of payment of a \$5.00 optional filing fee.

Candidates seeking election for Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the Republican Party (RPV) State Convention must submit the relevant filing form by March 09, 2020 and shall include with their filing form a check or evidence of payment of a \$35.00 filing fee.

Candidates seeking election for Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the Republican National Convention (RNC) must submit the relevant filing form by April 2, 2020 and shall include with their filing form a check or evidence of payment of a \$250 filing fee. Candidates may seek election for Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the RNC at the RPV State Convention, or at the District Convention, but not both.

If the number of persons prefilling as candidates for election at the Mass Meeting does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated for a particular office, once the appropriate Mass Meeting determines that such persons meet the requirements of Article I of the State Party Plan, the Mass Meeting Chair shall declare them elected or nominated.

Registration and Registration Fees

Registration for the Mass Meeting will begin at 6:30 PM and will end promptly at 7:00 PM.

Per the 1st District Call for a Convention a voluntary \$5.00 filing fee is requested to help defray the cost of the convention.

The mandatory two year membership dues for the King George Republican Committee are \$40.
