Boaters for TRUMP!

A sight replicated across America Saturday, September 5, was the TRUMP Boat Parade, seen above on the Piankatank River in Middlesex County. Witnesses counted 158 watercraft that participated—power boats, sailboats, jet skis, kayaks—all showing support for America and President Donald Trump by displaying flags, banners, big smiles and lots of enthusiasm. Especially encouraging to see were significant numbers of young people, many with small children on board. People along the route on shore showed appreciation and support by waving flags, banners and their hands.

Those of us on boats find these parades exhilarating, inspirational, and uplifting. At a time when there is so much negativity exhibited in our country, these events give proud

Americans a much-needed break and help reinforce that others believe as we do: President Trump is doing an outstanding job and deserves four more years to continue his efforts to Make America Great Again!

Another **TRUMP** boat parade will be Saturday, September 26, gathering at the mouth of Urbanna Creek at 1:00 p.m. and crossing the Rapphannock River into Carters Creek. Rain date will be September 27. Boaters who participate are asked to monitor VHF Channel 67.

At least one boat on the 26th is expected to carry a GADE for SENATE banner as Daniel Gade's Campaign Manager, Loren Hubbard, plans to be part of this tribute to America and our President.

GADE for SENATE campaign was in Gloucester, August 29. A crowd over 100 gathered at the Disabled American Veterans' headquarters to meet Dr. Daniel Gade and hear firsthand why he's working to win the seat in the United States Senate occupied by Mark Warner.
