

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the Poquoson Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Poquoson Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Colleen Holcomb, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Library 500 City Hall Ave, Poquoson, VA 23662, at 7:00 PM on Monday, April 1, 2024, with registration beginning at 6:00 PM, for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman;
- b) Electing Members of the Unit Committee;
- c) Electing up to two hundred ten (210) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 1st Congressional District Convention to be held at King William High School starting at 10:00 AM on Saturday, May 4, 2024, with registration beginning at 8:00 AM, for the following purposes:
 - Electing a District Chairman;
 - Electing three (3) Members of the State Central Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia;
 - Nominating one (1) Elector to be voted for in the presidential election on November 5, 2024; and
 - For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
 - Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per two hundred fifty (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Poquoson is entitled to forty-two (42) Delegate Votes.
- d) Electing up to two hundred ten (210) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the State Convention to be held at the Hampton Roads Convention Center starting at 2:30 PM on Friday, May 31, 2024, and 10:00 AM on Saturday, June 1, for the following purposes:
 - Electing a State Chairman;
 - Electing a National Committeeman and a National Committeewoman;
 - Nominating two (2) Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 5, 2024; and
 - For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
 - Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per two hundred fifty (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Poquoson is entitled to forty-two (42) Delegate Votes.
- e) For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Poquoson under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing

election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as Unit Chairman shall file a written statement, by mail or in person, to Colleen Holcomb, 720 Mall Pkwy, Newport News VA 23602, which must be received not later than 5:00 PM on March 22, 2024. Postmarks do not govern.

Candidates for election as a Member of the Poquoson Republican Committee must submit the filing form found on the Republican Party of Virginia website, virginia.gop, which states intent to seek election to the Committee. All forms, along with dues of \$20, must be received no later than 5:00 PM on March 22, 2024, either in person or by mail, to Colleen Holcomb, 720 Mall Pkwy, Newport News VA 23602. Postmarks do not govern.

Candidates for election as Delegate (or Alternate) to the May 4, 2024, 1st District Convention and/or Delegate (or Alternate) and the State Convention to be held May 31 and June 1, 2024, must submit the filing form found on the Republican Party of Virginia website, virginia.gop, which states intent to seek election for each specific position. All statements, along with applicable mandatory filing fees of \$10 for the 1st District Convention and/or \$45 for the State Convention, must be received not later than 5:00 PM on March 22, 2024, either in person or by mail, to Colleen Holcomb, 720 Mall Pkwy, Newport News VA 23602. Postmarks do not govern.

Cancellation

If the number of persons properly filed for all offices and positions to be decided upon by the Mass Meeting does not exceed the maximum number that can be elected for the respective offices and positions, those persons shall be deemed elected and the Mass Meeting will be canceled.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.
